



Mount Waverley Reservoir Water Main Renewal Project Community Bulletin - April 2023

In Melbourne, clean, reliable water is essential to our way of life.

The High Street Road (M76) water main plays an important role in transferring water between Silvan Reservoir, Mitcham Reservoir and Mt View Reservoir. It was constructed in 1928, has been repaired and relined in the past, and is nearing the end of its service life.

That's why at Melbourne Water we are replacing ageing water mains between the corner of High Street Road and Blackburn Road and Mount Waverley Reservoir.

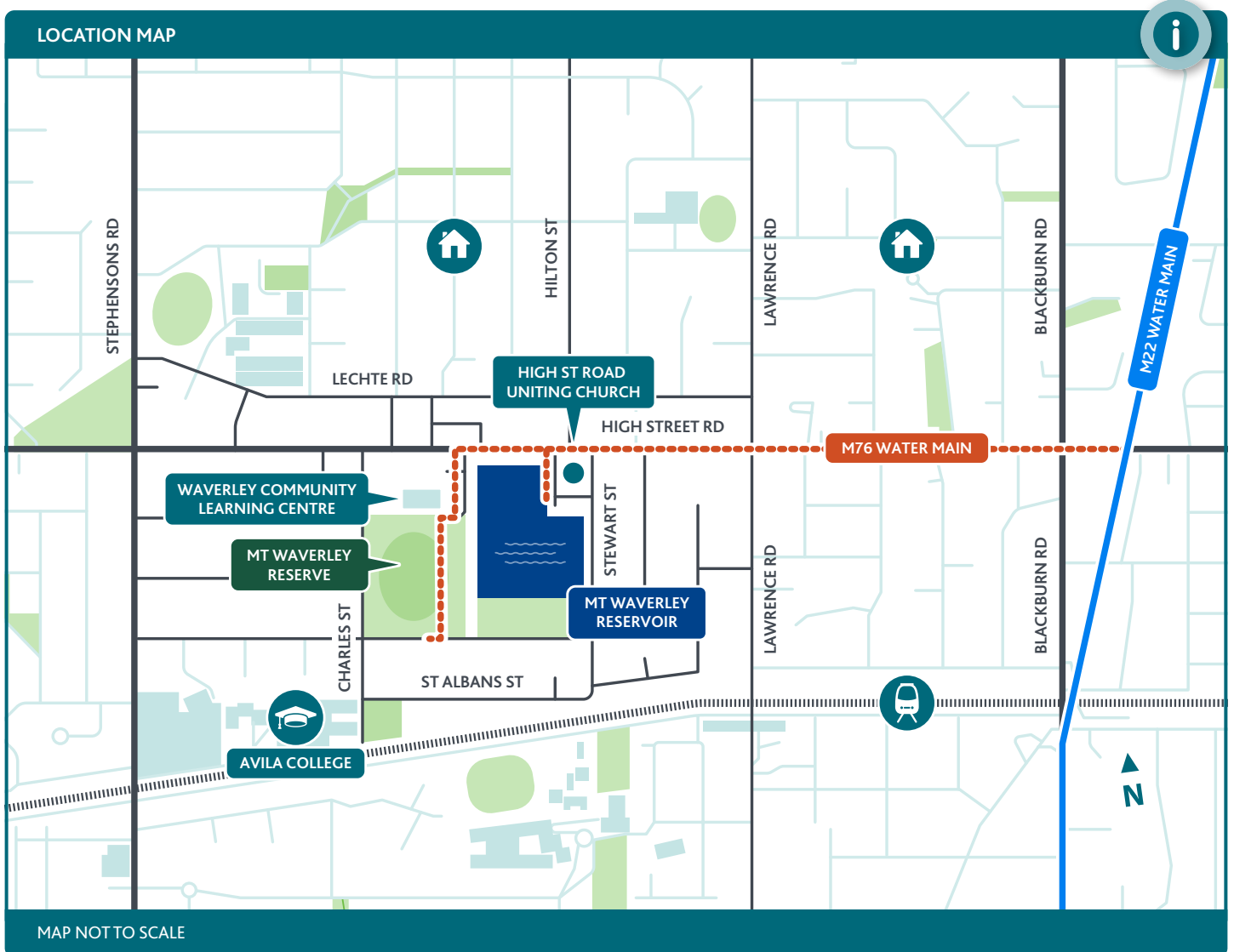
This work will ensure Melbourne Water can continue to supply our customers and the wider community with a safe and reliable water supply now and into the future.

What to expect

Whilst we will make every effort to ensure inconveniences are kept to a minimum, there will be some localised impacts:

Working hours

The majority of construction works will occur during standard construction hours between 7am and 6pm Monday to Friday and 7am and 1pm Saturdays.

Night works may be required where the pipeline crosses under roads to minimise traffic disruption. Residents and businesses will be advised if works are necessary outside these hours.

Noise and vibration

Some noise and vibration are expected during construction from trucks, machinery and reversing beepers. We will work closely with the appointed contractor to manage noise impacts as much as practicable.

Dust

Dust is to be expected throughout construction. The team will use water trucks to minimise this impact.

Impacts on local traffic and streets

To complete our works safely, there will be some changes to the traffic conditions. Approved traffic management contractors will be used to direct traffic, pedestrians and cyclists safely around our worksites. Local communities will be provided with more information about expected changes to traffic conditions, including the timing of planned activities, changes to traffic, access and parking conditions before starting work.

NO INTERRUPTIONS

There will be no interruption to your water supply during our works. If you experience any issues, contact your water retailer, Yarra Valley Water on 13 27 62.

Vegetation removal and trimming

An arborist has assessed that many of the Cyprus trees around Mount Waverley Reservoir are coming to the end of their life. Due to the risks of branches and limbs falling onto our neighbours or damaging the reservoir, the trees will be removed.

We are removing trees in stages, with trees near the work area being removed first as trenching and working beside trees can undermine their root systems, making them more unstable and unsafe.

The second stage of tree removal will occur in 2-3 years as part of a later project to strengthen the reservoir walls.

We are working closely with Monash Council to develop a reinstatement strategy that complements the Mount Waverley Reserve Master Plan and benefits the community.

背景情况介绍

Mt Waverley的饮用水供水管道自启用以来已有80多年。虽经多次修缮,但目前已不得不更换。

墨尔本水务公司 (Melbourne Water) 计划于High St Rd和Blackburn Rd的拐角处和Mount Waverley Reserve之间修建一条新的供水管道。

工程将可确保墨尔本水务公司继续为社区提供安全、可靠的饮用水。

项目日程

工程将于2023年7月动工,2024年12月完工。

潜在干扰

尽管我方将尽力减少对居民的影响,但仍会存在以下局部影响:

工作时间

工作时间为周一至周五上午7点至下午6点,周六上午7点至下午1点。

管道从道路下方穿过的阶段,可能会进行夜间施工,以尽量减少对日间交通的影响。

噪声和振动

作业期间,卡车、机械设备和倒车警报器会带来一定的噪音和振动。

扬尘

在整个施工过程中,预计会出现扬尘。作业团队将使用洒水车来尽量减少扬尘。

对本地交通和街道的影响

为安全完成工程作业,会对局部交通作一定临时变动。工地周边的交通安全将由交通管理合同商负责指挥调度。

树木移除

树木专家已对Mt Waverley水库周边的树木进行了评估。评估结果表明,这部分树木已处于自然寿命末期。出于社区安全考量,也为了避免树枝掉落和保持用水清洁,将对以上树木作砍伐移除处理。首先将会移除作业区域范围内的树木。其余树木将在后期的水库墙壁加固项目进程中(未来2-3年内)移除。

在与Monash市政府的配合下,我们目前正在根据Mt Waverley Reserve的总体规划,在保护区内种植树木。
