Lane closures within our work sites will remain in place to ensure the safety of all road users.

Works will recommence in the new year, from 7am, **Monday 08 January 2024**.

From our team, Merry Christmas and a Happy New Year 2024!

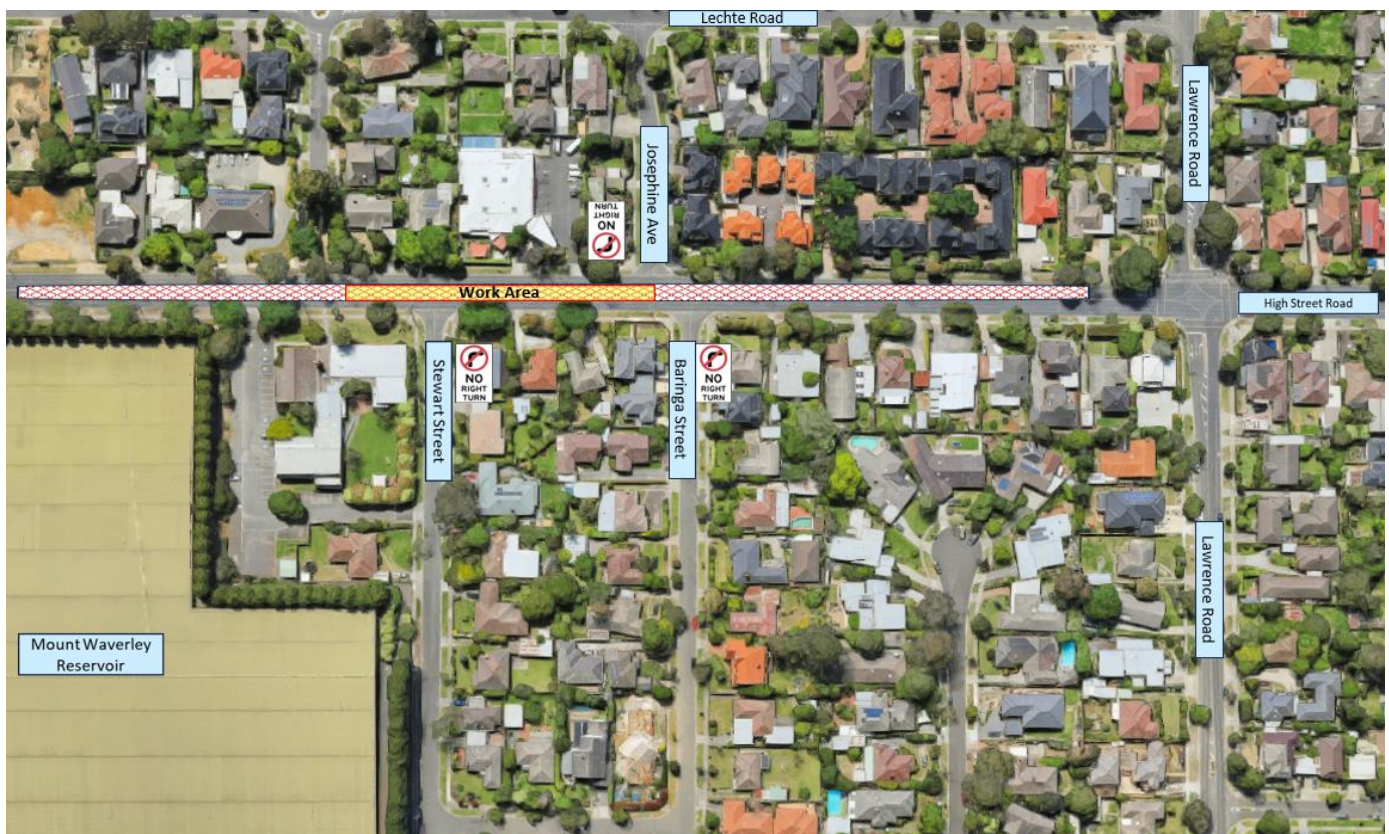


Figure 1: Map marking out the phases of works.

What to expect

Change in traffic: Traffic reduced to one lane in each direction on High Street Road. An increase in traffic on the roads surrounding High Street Road is anticipated. Please allow for extra travel time.

Detours: There will be no tight turn from the side roads next to our work sites. Follow detour signs.

Safety barriers will remain in place to keep the work site secure and road users safe.

Speed limit: Temporary speed limits of 40km/h will apply within the work site areas. Please exercise caution and drive carefully while driving past our work site.

Bus Service 734: To ensure the safety of residents, bus stops within the rolling work site will be temporarily closed. Early notice and direction will be provided. During construction you can plan ahead using the PTV app.

The project team would like you to know that the traders who proudly operate along High Street Road and Blackburn Road intersection will remain open for business during our works.

The project team will ensure there is adequate signage, traffic management and signed detours for vehicles and pedestrians. This will ensure people can still access the community shopping precinct- buy local, support local.
