

North Yarra Main Sewer Rehabilitation

Works Notification - Relining Day Works

What are we doing?

Relining works are about to begin on Section B of the North Yarra Main Sewer. The sewer line will be given a quick clean, prior to relining. Large trucks and machinery will be used to install the spiral wound liner.

Works are scheduled to start on **Monday, 4 March** and are expected to take **6 - 8 weeks** to complete.



What's happening	Timeline
Relining between NYM 115 - NYM 112	Commencing 4 March 2024 (3-4 weeks)
Relining between NYM 118 - NYM 115	Commencing 13 March 2024 (3-4 weeks)
Bypass set-up at NYM119 Operating 24 hours, 7days a week	Current – April 2024

There will be no interruption to your water or sewerage services during our works. If you experience any issues with your sewerage service, please contact Yarra Valley Water on 1300 304 688.

What to expect?

- **Traffic management** will be present to assist motorists, cyclists, and pedestrians around our temporary work sites. Short detours will be required where manholes are in the roadway. Please allow extra time when travelling through the area.
- **Noise** will be generated from the relining equipment. This noise can be compared to a lawn mower. We will implement noise reducing methods, where possible, to minimise disruption to the community.
- **Odour** will be present when opening and accessing the maintenance hole. While smelly, it's harmless and will disappear when we finish.



Working Hours

These works will be completed as part of **day works** between **7am to 6pm***, from **Monday to Friday***.

If required, we may work on Saturdays, from 7am to 2pm*.

**These times are indicative and subject to change with no prior notice due to weather conditions and fluctuating sewer flows.*
