

North Yarra Main Sewer Rehabilitation

Reinstatement night works starting 28 April*

We have completed relining works on the North Yarra Main Sewer Section B and reinstatement works within the maintenance holes used for relining are scheduled to start from **Sunday, 28 April 2024***. These works are expected to take 4-5 weeks* to complete.

What are we doing?

Internal fixtures that were removed from maintenance holes to accommodate relining equipment now need to be reinstated. This includes ladders, landings, and downpipes.

We will work our way from maintenance hole to maintenance hole and will be at each location for approximately 2-3 night shifts.



What to expect?

- **Traffic management** will be present to assist motorists, cyclists, and pedestrians around our temporary work sites. Short detours will be required where maintenance are in the roadway. Please allow extra time when travelling through the area.
- **Noise** will be generated from equipment used to install the fixtures. This noise can be compared to a lawn mower. We will implement noise reducing methods, where possible, to minimise disruption to the community.
- **Odour** will be present when opening and accessing the maintenance hole. While smelly, it's harmless and will disappear when we finish.
- Flow management will be set up at nearby maintenance holes to assist with works. This may include the use of a sucker truck to reduce sewage flows.

There will be no interruption to your water or sewerage services during our works. If you experience any issues with your sewerage service, please contact Yarra Valley Water on 1300 304 688.
