## Night works- safety barriers removal

## What can you expect

- Noise from construction equipment, construction activities and large vehicles.
- Full road closure from East of Blackburn Road / High Street Road intersection to Latham Court
- No right/left hand turns into High Street Road heading East from Blackburn Road
- Temporary traffic disruption. Please show caution when passing our work zone
- Bright lights will be used during night works. Where possible, lights will be directed away from neighbouring property windows.
- Traffic management will be present to assist motorists, cyclists, and pedestrians around our temporary work sites. Please allow extra travel time.
- Access for emergency service vehicles will be always maintained during these works.

**Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> June 2024** and **Tuesday 4<sup>th</sup> June 2024** from 10pm to 5am as permitted by the Department of Transport

Crews will be back to complete connection works, grouting and road resurfacing at a later date. Resident will be kept updated.
