North Yarra Main Sewer Rehabilitation

Sewer works commencing 1 October 2024

Works to complete installation of the new liner in the North Yarra Main Sewer are scheduled to start from **Tuesday 1 October 2024.**

What we are doing

We will work our way from maintenance hole to maintenance hole starting from The Boulevard/Mossman Drive intersection to the Burgundy Street/Rosanna Road intersection (*refer to map on the next page*). These works are anticipated to take approximately four days to complete (weather permitting).

Dates and times are subject to change due to weather conditions and fluctuating sewer flows.

What to expect

- **Traffic management** will be present to assist motorists, cyclists, and pedestrians around our temporary work sites. Short detours will be required where maintenance holes are in the roadway. Please allow extra time when travelling through the area.
- **Noise** will be generated from the construction equipment. This noise can be compared to a lawn mower. We will implement noise reducing methods, where possible, to minimise disruption to the community.
- **Bright lights** will be used during night works. Where possible, lights will be directed away from neighbouring properties.
- **Odour** will be present when opening and accessing the maintenance hole. While smelly, it's harmless and will disappear when we finish.
