Mount Waverley water main renewal project

Night works - Fleet Street and High Street Road connections

The Mount Waverley Water main renewal project is nearing completion, with connection works on High Street Road between Fleet Street and Stewart Street due to commence the week of **17 October 2024**. These works will assist with the final stages of preparing the new pipeline for use.

What are we doing

To safely complete works there will be a **full road closure** on High Street Road, between Charles Street and Stewart Street (refer to map). Works will be at night between **9pm and 5am** when traffic movement is at its lowest and will take approximately **four weeks** to complete (weather permitting).

When: Thursday 17 October 2024 to Friday 15 November 2024

Time: 9pm – 5am (Monday to Friday)

What to expect (nighttime only)

Change in traffic: Local traffic access only between Fleet Street and Stewart Street (refer to map).

Detours (nighttime only): Local traffic will be detoured around the work area (refer to map):

- Eastbound traffic will be detoured via Lechte Road and Lawrence Road.
- Westbound traffic will be detoured via Stewart Street, St Albans Street and Charles Street.
- Heavy vehicles will be detoured at Stephenson's Road and Blackburn Road via Waverley Road or Burwood Highway.
- Please allow extra travel time during this period

Local traders: Access to High Street Road businesses will be maintained. To stay safe, please follow all instructions from traffic controllers.

Lights: Temporary light towers may be required during this time. Where possible, they will be positioned to face away from residential properties.

Parking: There will be limited parking in front of the Fleet Street shops. Traffic management will be present to help residents navigate the area.

Noise and vibration: Our trucks and machinery will create noise and minor vibration associated with the excavation of the road. Where possible, sound dampening methods will be applied.

Out of hours: When we are not working on High Street Road, metal plates will be secured over the road to ensure safe driving conditions. Speed limits will apply.

Pedestrian access: Footpaths around the work section on Fleet Street and High Street Road will be closed with detours in place. All other footpaths will remain open. Please travel safely around the work area.

What's next

Night works will be undertaken intermittently along High Street Road until December (weather permitting) as we finish the final pipeline connections and permanent reinstatement. These works are scheduled at night to ensure reduced traffic impacts. Further information with dates will be provided.
