In an exciting update, the elements for the cultural immersive trail are currently in the process of being installed and will be ready to explore at the community event! Using a mix of signage, art and digital media, the trail will highlight the cultural and natural values of the creek as a place owned, lived in and celebrated by Wurundjeri people.

## More planting to come!

We'll be back in the Autumn and Winter months to do more planting when weather and ground conditions are more favourable. This will include a combination of native trees, shrubs and ground covers to fill in gaps. Plantings in the terracing space and boardwalk area will help to blend the rockwork and infrastructure in with the natural surroundings.
