We may be unable to process your application if your information is incomplete.

If your licence is approved, this information will be available to Melbourne Water staff, and its agents and contractors and the Victorian Department of Energy, Environment, and Climate Action to the extent necessary to administer and communicate with you about your licence. Subject to other laws, your information will be included in, and publicly available through, the Victorian Water Register (www.waterregister.vic.gov.au), in accordance with Part 4B of the Water Act 1989. The register is administered by the Victorian Department of Energy, Environment, and Climate Action.

We may also share your name and contact details with contractors for the purpose of customer experience research. De-identified information about your licence will be used for statistical water information.
