Dear Resident,

Williamstown Main Sewer Rehabilitation Project – Night works

The project will be accessing manholes on Pasco Street on **Thursday 20 April 2017** from **8pm to 6am** to trial and measure sewer flow controls.

Works will involve accessing the manholes located near the intersections of Pasco and Cecil Streets and also Pasco and Aitken Streets to install temporary flow control devices to control the sewage flow. A second team will be located on Railway Place near the Williamstown Beach train station to monitor and control the flow volumes.

Residents will see a small working crew and their working vehicles around the respective manhole.

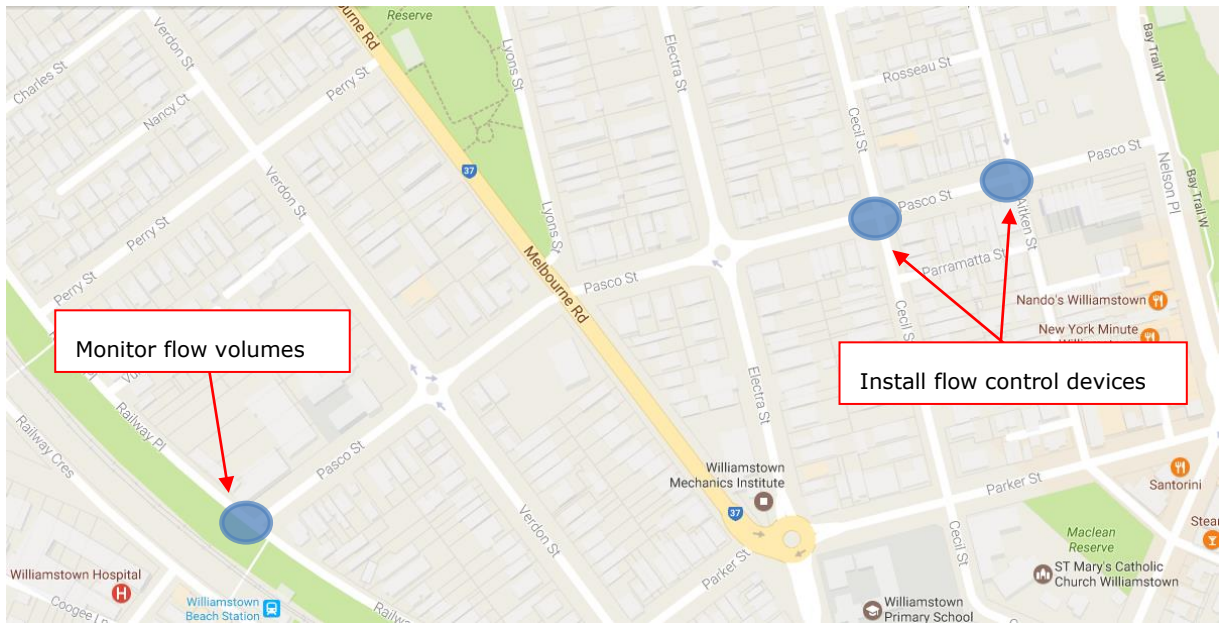
Please note plugging sewer mains is a standard practice and will not affect the normal operation of the sewer.

The team will continue to access these manholes for approximately **3 months**. The team may access during the day and night depending on flows and as necessary to complete works along the sewer alignment. Please be careful around work areas and observe new signs.

What to expect?

We will take every possible precaution to minimise any impact during these works. Some impacts to our neighbours may include:

- Some odour when the manhole is first opened
- Some noise from the movement of trucks and machinery
- Temporary lane/ road closures and changes to the speed limits near work areas
