Dear Resident,

Williamstown Main Sewer Rehabilitation Project – Stage 1

Stage 1 of the Williamstown Main Sewer Rehabilitation Project is due to start in your area the week commencing **3 April 2017**. Works for this stage will involve digging up the top of the manhole to ensure safe access into the sewer for stage 2 sewer relining works.

These works will take approximately **3-5 working days** to complete for each manhole and will be performed during the day between **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday** and occasionally on Saturday's between 7am to 1pm. Please be careful around work areas and observe new signs.

What to expect?

- Some odour when the manhole is first opened
- Some noise from the movement of trucks, machinery and reversing beepers
- Changes to parking and traffic conditions
- Please see map and table below for location and timing of the works, traffic and parking impacts.







Manhole 30 Pasco Street and Cecil Street intersection	 Road closure in place at the intersection with detour signage to assist road users around these works. Pedestrian access will be maintained around the works.
Manhole 29 Pasco Street and Aitken Street intersection	 Road closure in place at the intersection with detour signage to assist road users around these works. Pedestrian access will be maintained around the works. Up to 4 car parks will be occupied on Pasco Street to ensure a safe working area.
Manhole 31 Pasco Street and Electra Street roundabout	 Road closures in place at the roundabout with detour signage to assist road users around these works. Pedestrian access will be maintained around the works. During excavation tree root pruning may be undertaken as required to protect the health of the tree, and an arborist will be on call to assist as necessary.
Manhole 28 Nelson Place opposite Pasco Street intersection	 Restricted two way traffic on Nelson Place. Pedestrian access will be maintained around these works. Tree canopy trimming on Nelson Place. The Hobsons Bay City Council will be performing the trimming on behalf of the project.

CPB Black and Veatch Joint Venture will be undertaking these works on behalf of Melbourne Water.
