Williamstown Main Sewer Rehabilitation Project

The project will be accessing manholes again on Forster Street, Williamstown, to place temporary flow control devices in order to carry out works on Pasco Street for the next **3 months**.

These works will take place during the day between **7am to 6pm Monday to Friday** and occasionally on Saturday's between 7am to 1:30pm.

Please note plugging sewer mains is a standard practice and will not affect the normal operation of the sewer.

What to expect?

We will take every possible precaution to minimise any impact during these works. Some impacts to our neighbours may include:

- Some odour when the manhole is first opened
- Some noise from the movement of trucks and machinery
- Temporary lane/ road closures and changes to the speed limits near work areas

Please be careful around work areas and observe new signs.
